1. How do I find a specific index?

- Locate the search box titled "Search by Keyword or Index" on the top right corner of the Webpage.
- Input the S&P index name you are looking for in the search box. As you type, a drop-down menu will appear with the specific index you are looking for, or indices with a similar name.
- If you see the index you are searching for, select it from the drop-down menu. From there, you will be navigated directly to the specific index page.
- If you do not see the specific index you are looking for in the drop-down list, click on the red "Search" button after you type the index name. From there, you will be navigated to an advanced search page with additional indices listed and advanced search options.

2. Where can I locate month-end price and total return performance? (S&P 500[®], S&P MidCap 400[®], and S&P SmallCap 600[®] Indices only)?

- Navigate to the respective index page you are searching for.
- On the left hand side of the page, under the index description, click on "ADDITIONAL INFO" located in the light grey box, and click on S&P 500 Month-End Performance, S&P MidCap 400 Month-End Performance, or S&P SmallCap 600 Month-End Performance, respectively.

3. Where would I find five years of daily historical price and total return levels for all of the S&P Indices on the site?

- Navigate to the respective index page you are searching for.
- Using the performance graph on the right hand side of the screen you will find six tabs listed as MTD, QTD, YTD, 1 Year, 3 Year and 5 year. Click on the daily history frequency require and then click on the red box labeled “EXPORT.” The history of values selected will then open up to an excel spreadsheet.

4. Where can I locate the closing index total return?

- Once you are on the specific index page, a performance graph will appear on the right, under the “PERFORMANCE” tab in the data widget displayed (the page is defaulted to showcase the “PERFORMANCE” tab).
- Click on the table view icon on the top right of the performance graph and to the left of the EXPORT button. The total return value and performance as of the previous business day will appear.

5. Where are sector weightings located on the site?

- Once you are on the specific index page, a performance graph will appear to the right. Select the last tab titled “SECTOR BREAKDOWN.”

6. How do I find the S&P 500 GICS Sector Scorecard?

- Use the following link to the S&P 500 index page or navigate to the S&P 500 page using the search box on the top right of the Website:

- On the left hand side of the page, under the index description, click on “ADDITIONAL INFO” located in the light grey box, and then click on the “S&P 500 GICS Sector Scorecard” option from the drop-down menu.
