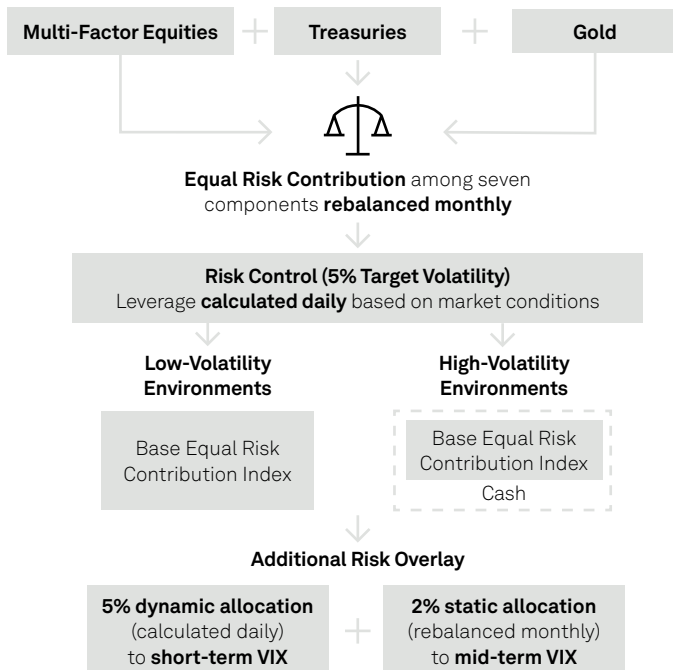
S&P MAESTRO 5 Index

A Sophisticated Composition for Risk Management

The S&P MAESTRO 5 (Multi-Asset Equal Risk Factor Contribution) Index is a **multi-asset, multi-factor, risk parity strategy** designed to help market participants manage volatility across changing market conditions.

The index seeks to provide **equal risk** allocation across its diverse mix of **equities, fixed income, and commodities**. To protect against unexpected volatility, a leveraged position is calculated daily to adjust exposure to the Base Equal Risk Contribution Index and maintain a **target volatility of 5%**. Finally, an allocation to **VIX® futures** serves as an additional layer of downside protection that dynamically responds to risk signals.

How Does the S&P MAESTRO 5 Index Work?



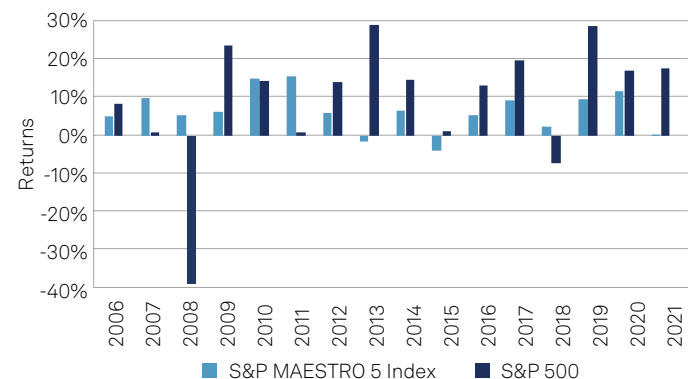
