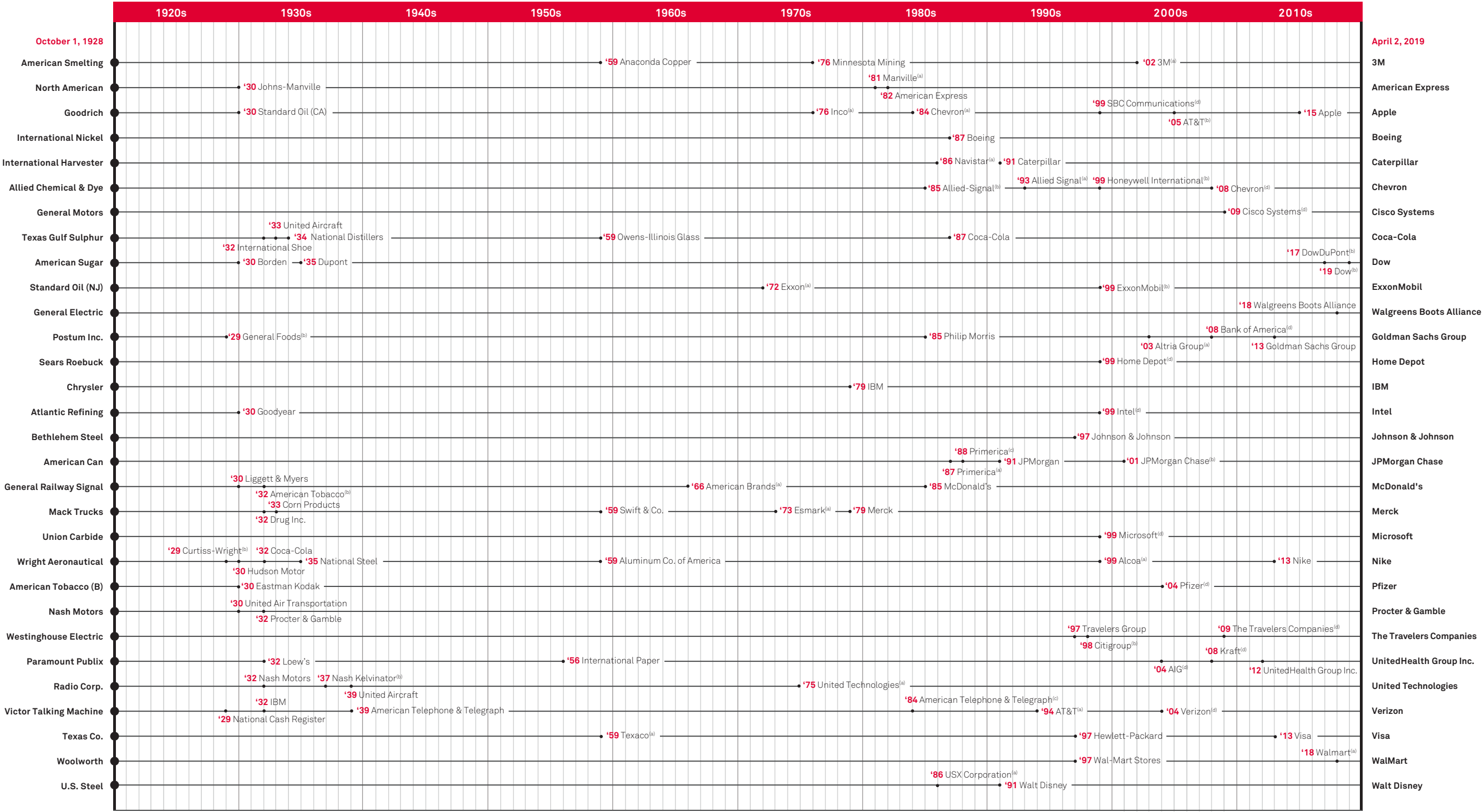


The Changing Dow Jones Industrial Average®



How to read this chart

To track changes in components, begin in the column for 1928 and work across. For instance, American Sugar was replaced by Borden in 1930, which in turn was replaced by Dupont in 1935.

Year of change is shown in red, bold face.

- a Denotes name change
- b Denotes a takeover, merger, or spinoff resulting in a name change
- c Indicates that a new company has adopted the name of a prior component
- d Indicates stocks that were added to The Dow® not as one-for-one replacement of departing stocks, but rather as part of a broader view
