

Dow Jones Equal Weight U.S. Issued Corporate Bond Index Consultation Results – Postponement

NEW YORK, MAY 24, 2018: As previously announced, S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) has concluded a consultation with members of the investment community on potential changes to the Dow Jones Equal Weight U.S. Issued Corporate Bond Index.

The changes that were set to take effect prior to market open on June 1, 2018 will be postponed until further notice. S&P DJI will provide notification at least 30 days in advance of the new effective date. The current methodology will remain effective until then.
