

Dow Jones Arabia Titans 50 Index Consultation on Eligible Index Universe Results

MUMBAI, SEPTEMBER 2, 2020: S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) has conducted a consultation with market participants on a potential change to the Dow Jones Arabia Titans 50 Index.

In order to ensure the index captures the largest companies traded on the major exchanges of Arab markets that are established and open to international investors, S&P DJI will include Saudi Arabia in the eligible index universe. The table below summarizes the change.

Index Universe	The index universe comprises all companies domiciled in and traded on the major exchanges of Bahrain, Egypt, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Morocco, Oman, Qatar, Tunisia, and the United Arab Emirates. In addition, S&P DJI will institute a country cap in order to ensure adequate country representation within the index. The table below summarizes the change.

Country Representation	--	No country can have more than 15 companies in the index.

These changes will be implemented in conjunction with the upcoming rebalancing, which takes effect prior to the market open on Monday, September 21, 2020.
