

Metlifecare Limited to be removed from the S&P/NZX Indices

SYDNEY, OCTOBER 13, 2020: S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) announced today that it will remove Metlifecare Limited (XNZE: MET) from the S&P/NZX Indices, subject to final court approval of the scheme of arrangement whereby the company will be acquired by Asia Pacific Village Group Limited.
