Orion Office REIT Set to Join S&P SmallCap 600

NEW YORK, November 9, 2021: Orion Office REIT Inc. (NYSE:ONL) will replace Daktronics Inc. (NASDAQ:DAKT) in the S&P SmallCap 600 effective prior to the opening of trading on Tuesday, November 16. S&P 500 constituent Realty Income Corp. (NYSE: O) is spinning off Orion Office REIT in a transaction expected to be completed on November 15. Daktronics is no longer representative of the small-cap market space.
