

S&P Real Assets Indices Consultation on Component Index Change – Results

NEW YORK, JUNE 13, 2025: S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) conducted a [consultation](#) with market participants on a potential change to the S&P Real Asset Indices.

As a result of the S&P Global Developed Sovereign Inflation-Linked Bond USD Index decommissioning effective after the close on Friday, June 27, 2025, S&P DJI is replacing the current fixed income component index with the iBoxx Global Inflation-Linked Index All USD¹ for the S&P Real Assets Indices.

IMPLEMENTATION TIMING

S&P DJI is implementing the previously described methodology change with an ad hoc rebalancing effective prior to the market open on **June 30, 2025**. The change will first be visible to clients in daily files beginning on **June 26, 2025**.
