S&P DJI is reclassifying Poland as follows:

Poland	Emerging	Developed

S&P DJI is not reclassifying Egypt; Egypt remains classified as Emerging.

Country	Current Classification	No Change
Egypt	Emerging	Emerging

IMPLEMENTATION TIMING

S&P DJI is implementing the Poland reclassification with the **September 2027** reconstitution. S&P DJI will also ensure the timely publication of the list of impacted indices as the deadline approaches.
